This dissertation proposes an analytical framework for studying the governance of information security transactions within the State Bank of Vietnam's banking system in the current context. It emphasizes the environment and governance effectiveness, which is a novel aspect of the dissertation.

The dissertation focuses on the governance of information security transactions within the State Bank of Vietnam's banking system, offering a new perspective compared to previous studies that often focused on technical or legal aspects.

The dissertation applies the principles of information security governance to the field of information security within the State Bank of Vietnam's banking system, particularly through electronic authentication.

The dissertation proposes feasible solutions to contribute to ensuring information security within the State Bank of Vietnam's banking system through the governance of information security transactions, rather than relying solely on technical or legal solutions. Simultaneously, it provides new data to enhance understanding of the information security situation in the banking sector and the need to strengthen the governance of information security transactions within the State Bank of Vietnam's banking system in the future, meeting practical requirements.
